The agency within the Department that has the specific responsibility of licensed and unlicensed psychotherapists is: State Grievance Board, 1560 Broadway Street, Denver, Colorado 80202.   - a. You are entitled to receive information from me about my methods of therapy, the techniques I use, the duration of my therapy (if determinable), my cancellation policy, billing methods and my fee schedule.
  - b. You can seek a second opinion from another therapist or terminate therapy at any time.
  - c. In a professional relationship such as ours, sexual intimacy between therapist and client is never appropriate. If sexual intimacy occurs, it should be reported to the State Grievance Board (see address above).
6. Generally speaking, information provided by and to a client during therapy sessions is legally confidential if the therapist is a licensed clinical social worker, licensed professional counselor, a licensed psychologist or an unlicensed psychotherapist practicing under the supervision of a licensed psychotherapist. Certain specific situations, as defined by statute, are required to be reported. Information can be required to be disclosed by court order or by subpoena. You should be aware that, except in the case of information given to a licensed psychologist, legal confidentiality does not apply in a criminal, delinquency or dependency or neglect proceeding.
